**Sub: First meeting of all program officers (NSS) of University Schools of Studies (USS) and Affiliated Colleges under GGSIP University.**

**Dear All,**

GGSIPU NSS Cell was formed on 08<sup>th</sup> February, 2018. You all aware, that the National Service Scheme (NSS), a voluntary and value based student youth programme which was launched in 1969 by Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports in pursuance of one of the recommendations of the Education Commission. NSS aims at the personality and character development of students in schools and colleges. Usually NSS units are either classified as a regular NSS and Self Financing Units (SFUs).

The SFUs are entitled to all the benefits of the scheme at par with Government-funded (Regular) NSS units, the only difference being that the expenditure on setting up such units is required to be borne by the education institutions concerned. Till date, seven regular units (consisting of 100 student volunteers in each) have been established in all USS and seven regular units have been established in Affiliated Government Institutes of GGSIPU. Twenty Three Self Financing NSS Units (SFUs) are formed in twenty three Affiliated Institutes of GGSIPU. Efforts are made to set up NSS units in other 105 Affiliated Institutes of GGSIPU.

A meeting of all NSS program officers is scheduled to be held on **20<sup>th</sup> December, 2019, 03:00 PM at C-Block Seminar Hall, GGSIP University Campus.**

The agenda of the meeting is to orient the program officers in executing NSS activities at their respective institutions / colleges. A roadmap will be decided during the interaction for developing NSS Units and promoting NSS regular activities and special camping activities. This will be followed by a lecture on ***“Mapping Fundamental Duties in Contemporary Scenario”***, by ***Prof. Amar Pal Singh, Dean, USLLS*** as a part of the plan for Celebration of ‘Constitution Day’ on 26th November, 2019 and subsequent activities culminating in Dr. Ambedkar Jayanti on 14th April, 2019.

All Principal / Directors of affiliated institutions are advised to kindly attend or send their nominees to attend the same for setting up of NSS units at their respective Institutes / Colleges (If not already set up). This will help motivate the institutions to establishing the NSS-SFU at their campus and further discuss the annual plan of the respective NSS units.
