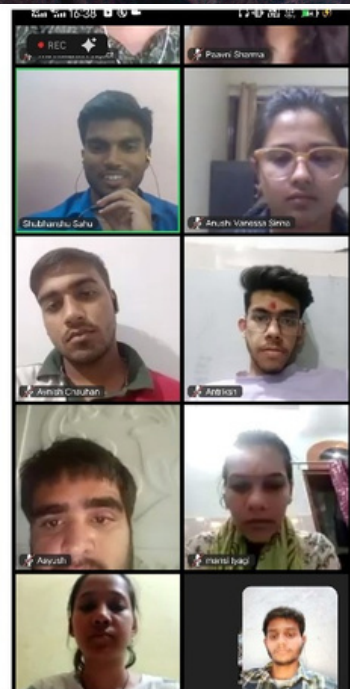

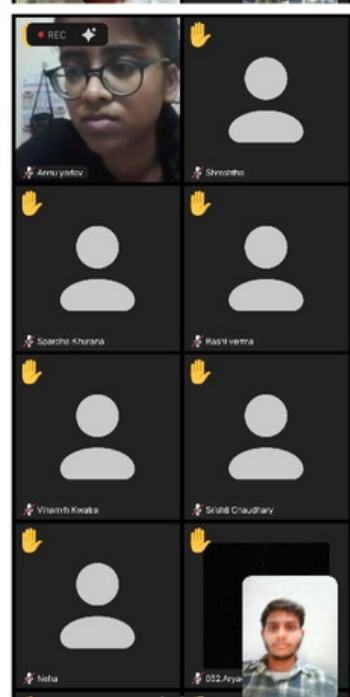

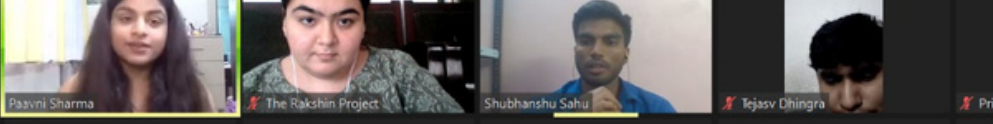

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- Emotional reactions
Fear, shame, humiliation, guilt and self-blame
Depression and anxiety.
- Symptoms of posttraumatic stress
Intrusive or recurring thoughts of the abuse
Nightmares or flashbacks.
- Distorted self-perception
They caused the sexual abuse
They deserved it
Self-destructive relationships.
- Substance Abuse
- Suicide

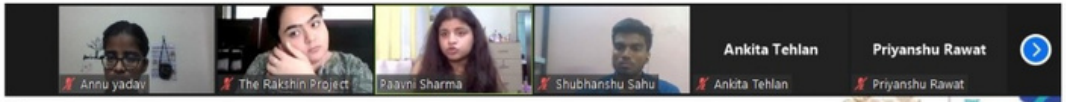

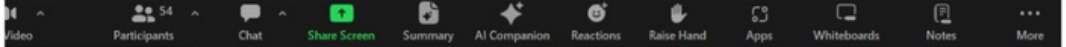
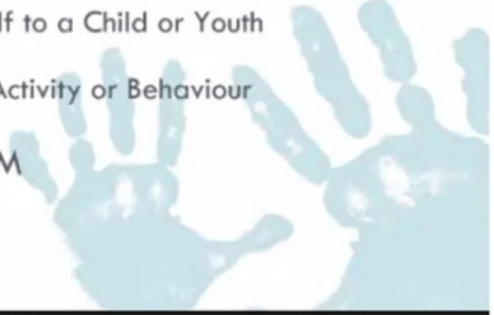
