PRIME MINISTER'S SCHOLARSHIP SCHEME FOR THE WARDS OF CENTRAL ARMED POLICE FORCES & ASSAM RIFLES AND STATE POLICE PERSONNEL FOR ACADEMIC SESSION 2019-20

Government of India has announced Prime Minister's Scholarship Scheme for the dependent wards and widows of Central Armed Police Forces and Assam Rifles (CAPF's & AR) killed / disabled in action for Government service and State Police Personnel (SPP) martyred during Terror/ Naxal attacks. These include a total of 2000 scholarships for students under CAPF's & AR and 500 scholarships under SPP to be equally distributed among girls and boys. The scholarship shall be given to a candidate for the whole duration of the programme or for a maximum limit of 5 years. For renewal of the scholarship, at least 50% marks are required in each year of progression while pursuing the programme.

Eligibility and Application Procedure:-

- Applicant is required to submit documentary evidence for being considered in either of the two schemes.
- She/He must have obtained at least 60% marks in the minimum entry qualification i.e., 10+2/Diploma/Graduation or equivalent in case of a new applicant.
- Students are required to apply online on the website of National Scholarship Portal (NSP 2.0) i.e. www.sholarship.gov.in before 15th December 2019.

Students are advised to go through the guidelines available on the website and ensure fulfillment of all mandatory requirements in respect of the specific documentary evidence of eligibility before applying. After submitting the application online, please also submit a hard copy of the same alongwith scanned necessary supporting documents, fee receipts, Self-Declaration, and Bonafide certificate (issued by respective Dean of the School). Thereafter, Deans of schools will forward applications duly attested and recommended to the Planning Branch for verification by the Nodal Officer. Any other information may kindly be obtained from Planning branch, Room No. 21, Administrative Block, Guru Gobind Singh Indraprastha University.
