

A candidate also must have passed in English (core or selective or function) as a subject of studies in the qualifying examination. OR Diploma in Radiotherapy Technology after pass in 12 <sup>th</sup> class of CBSE or equivalent with minimum aggregate of 50% marks in Physics, Chemistry and Biology provided the candidate has passed in each subject separately, having minimum 5 years of experience in the field of Radiotherapy.
2.	Holy Family Hospital Delhi, Okhla Road, Okhla, New Delhi-110025	B. Sc. Medical Imaging Technology (MIT)/ 3 Years	134	15	Candidates who have passed 10+2 of CBSE or equivalent examination with a minimum aggregate of 50% marks for general students in Science stream that includes Physics, Chemistry and Biology.

In the case of SC, ST, PH. and Defence categories the 5% relaxation of aggregate marks required in the qualifying examination.

The University shall be uploading the Notification on Monday i.e. 26.10.2020, giving details of procedure of submitting the application for admission in these two programmes alongwith other relevant details.

The admissions in these two programmes shall be on the basis of merit of the candidate in the Common Entrance Test which will be conducted by the University.
