be filled in the Counselling. All the eligible candidates (irrespective of any category and region) whose name have been displayed in the merit list and have relevant work experience and NOC for seeking admission and not taken admission in MBA programme on Weekend basis. For seeking admission in MBA - Weekend programme, eligibility criteria mentioned in Admission Brochure- 2020-21 may be referred.

Document(s) required at the time of Extended Open House Counselling /Admission.

- Bank Draft(s) of Rs. 82,000/- drawn in favor of Registrar, Guru Gobind Singh Indraprastha University payable at Delhi. No seat will be allotted without Bank Draft.
- Filled-in Verification Form as per Appendix: 4 (a) of Admission Brochure 2020-21
- Certificate and Mark Sheet of the qualifying examination issued by the Board/ University.
- Conduct and Character Certificate from the Head of the Institution from where the qualifying examination has been passed or from Gazetted Officer/Notary Public /Current employer (Original and One Photocopy)
- Certificate of Medical Fitness to be signed by a Registered Medical Practitioner holding a degree not lower than MBBS in the format as given in Appendix: 6 (Original).
- No-Objection Certificate from the employer for pursuing the programme if not submitted earlier.

In Extended Open House Counselling the vacant seats shall be offered to the qualified candidate(s) in order of merit irrespective of his/her Region provided he/she has not taken admission up-till in this programme and has reported for counselling on this day.

Instruction to be followed at the time of Extended Open House Counselling

- The Supplementary Counselling will commence from rank one onwards for all categories and the seats will be allotted strictly on the basis of merit of the candidates. Such candidates, who were absent in the First, Second Counselling and Open House Counselling will also be permitted to attend the Extended Open House counselling.
- b. A candidate, who fails to appear in person on the notified date and time for counselling, shall forfeit his/her claim
- C. Admission will be made strictly on merit basis (Rank-wise) and counselling/admissions will stop when all the seats get filled-up.
- d. A candidate, who fails to exercise the option in person shall forfeit his/her right for a vacant seat even if he or she had higher rank, for which the University will not be responsible.
