WWW.IPU.AC.IN**

1. It is for information of all the stakeholders that the process of submission of Online Application Forms for admissions for all the programmes being conducted in the University School of Studies and affiliated institutes during the Academic Session 2020-21 has already commenced with effect from 03.03.2020. The link for initiating the process for filling up of online form and thereafter for submission has been provided on the University Website [www.ipu.ac.in](http://www.ipu.ac.in).
2. The University has already uploaded the complete Admission Brochure on the University Website for enabling the candidates to read the names of the programmes, eligibility, other relevant conditions for all the programmes and the admission procedure in different programmes etc.
3. As stated in the Admission Brochure it is once again informed to all the candidates desirous of seeking admission in various programmes being conducted in University School of Studies and Affiliated institutes that the University shall carry out admission on the basis of merit either in the
  - (i) **National Level Test (conducted by the respective agencies / organizations),**  
or
  - (ii) **the CET being conducted by GGSIP University**  
or
  - (iii) **on the basis of merit in the qualifying examination**
4. That some of the details are being reproduced below for information of candidates
  - a) **Programmes for admission on the basis of merit of National Level Test conducted by the respective agencies / organizations**

The details of programmes in which the admissions shall be made on the basis of National Level Tests are given in detail in Chapter 04 of the Admission

Brochure 2020-21. It is for information of all such candidates who have appeared or are appearing in the National Level Tests (e.g. NEET UG for MBBS and other UG medical courses, CLAT for LLB, CAT for MBA, CMAT for MBA, JEE for B.Tech. or other National Level Tests) that it is mandatory for each candidate to fill the online application form of the GGSIP University for seeking admission on the basis of the merit of National Level Test. Therefore all candidates desirous of seeking admission in the programmes on the basis of merit of National Level Test are requested to kindly ensure that they fill the online form and submit the same online form by paying the requisite fee of Rs.1200/-.

b) Programmes for admission on the basis of merit of CET to be conducted by GGSIP University

The details of programmes in which the admissions shall be made on the basis of the merit in the CET which will be conducted by the GGSIP University in Computer Based Test (CBT) mode are also given in detail in Chapter 04 of the Admission Brochure 2020-21. Therefore all such candidates desirous of seeking admission in the programmes on the basis of merit of CET to be conducted by GGSIP University through CBT mode are also requested to kindly ensure that they fill the online form and submit the same online form by paying the requisite fee of Rs.1200/-.

(c) Programmes for admission on the basis of merit of Qualifying Examination

The details of programmes in which the admissions shall be made on the basis of the merit of Qualifying Examination are also given in detail in Chapter 04 of the Admission Brochure 2020-21. Therefore all such candidates desirous of seeking admission in the programmes on the basis of merit of Qualifying Examination are also requested to kindly ensure that they fill the online form and submit the same online form by paying the requisite fee of Rs.1200/-.

5. In order to facilitate the candidates in filling the online application form the University has

  - (b) also has established a facilitation centre in the University campus for the candidates who personally visit the university campus.
