NOTICE

FIRST ALL INDIAN VIMARSH ONLINE SPEECH COMPETITION

University School of Law and Legal Studies is organising “Vimarsh online speech competition” for all students of Indian Universities, Colleges.

Guidelines for the Online Speech Competition:-

- ❖ The participants shall have to register for the competition through means of online registration through Google form.
- ❖ The confirmed participants shall be informed through email about the same.
- ❖ The participants have to send their entries in the form of a video which shall be uploaded on our social media platforms – on Facebook, Instagram and YouTube. Participants shall be informed of confirmation of participation through email.
- ❖ Upon confirmation of participation, the participants shall be sending their speech recorded as video on the said email address.
- ❖ The size of the video shall not be more than 60-70 MB.
- ❖ The entry which gets the maximum number of “likes” and “views” along with the decision of the organizers shall be the winner.
- ❖ The theme for the competition shall be–“**New World order in wake of Covid – 19 – Opportunities and encumbrances**” / “**कोविड - १९केउपरांतनयीविश्व-व्यवस्था –अवसर एवं रुकावटें**”.
- ❖ Entries not matching the required criteria or received after the requisite time shall be considered as disqualified.
- ❖ The participants have to mail their performances in video to our official Gmail account – usllscompetitions.ggsipu@gmail.com
- ❖ Only the entries received before 12 noon of 28th May will be entertained.
- ❖ The winner shall be declared on 1st June, 2020.
- ❖ E-certificates to all the participants.

RULES

- Maximum time limit is 3 minutes.
- Use of background music or props is prohibited.
- Use of unparliamentary language or socially, morally suggestive expressions shall be prohibited.
- Irrelevant content will not be considered.
- The medium of language is both English and Hindi.

The judging criteria shall be as follows :-

- 60% weightage shall be given by the judges of the event.
- The judges shall mark the videos on the basis of :
 - a) Content (10 marks)
 - b) Clarity (10 marks)
 - c) Conveyance (10 marks)
 - d) Cognitiveness(10 marks)
- 40% weightage shall be given to the number of likes received on the videos.

Depending on the average of “Likes” received on all the videos, the weightage of each like shall be calculated.

- There shall be no registration fees for the competition.
- The organizers shall not be responsible for any technical glitch in the transactions related to the competition.
- It shall be the participant’s duty to inform the organizers of issue that they are facing in requisite time so that it shall be resolved as possible.
- The organizers shall have the right to make any change in the rules and criteria or to call off any part or the whole of the competition without prior intimation.
- Decision of thee organizers shall be final and binding.

The total of the score received in jury’s assessment shall be calculated and the same shall be done for “Likes” and “Views”. Thereupon, 40% of the marks of Jury’s review and 60% of the score in Likes and Views shall be calculated to get the final score.
