## About NEEV foundation

It is Non-Profit Organisation based in Delhi and a Public Charitable Trust, Pro-bono Legal Work, Legal Advocacy, Legal Education and Equitable Access to Justice. This Foundation for Legal Aid was founded in July 2020, with the aim of enabling access to justice for the urban poor in Delhi. Created with the mission of expanding access to the law—in particular, to victims of human rights violations, and in cases concerning women's and children's rights. Neev is presently operational out of two Centres, located in Delhi.

## Activity

Mishika's work has primarily been focused on the rights of women. She holds a Bachelors in Journalism and Bachelors of Laws from the University of Delhi. She also holds an LLM from the United Nations Interregional Crime and Justice Research Institute (in association with University of Peace) where she studied Transnational Crime and Justice.

She has been working in this field with women from 10-12 years, spoke about rights and duties of women who are subjected to domestic violence, and explained the recent laws, problems in finding lawyers, financial issues, societal problem, physical violence.

- legal awareness on domestic violence

Four types of abuse under The Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005 are: "Physical abuse", "sexual abuse", "verbal and emotional abuse", and "economic abuse."

- Talked on domestic violence act (as complaint to be filed against whom).

Then solutions discussed: to make compromise (foundation takes initiative firstly for a compromise between spouses and also keep surveillance on the complainants after filing complaint).

- Discussing problems while filling complaint with female police
- If police officer do not registering the FIR under domestic violence act, then she directly made the complaint to the area Magistrate under Section 156 (3) CrPC.
- Next major issue discussed about advocate
- Solution was given about free legal aid to every women through State Legal service authorities.
- Foundation also provide comfort in selecting female over male advocates if uncomfortable.
- Make the awareness about several types of orders under the Domesti Violence Act such as Protection Order, Residence Order, Shelter Order, Interim Order, Custody Order and Compensation Order.
