- ii) Registration for SPOT Round II will be for all <u>NATA 2022/ JEE 2022</u> qualified candidates irrespective of his/her registration earlier.
- iii) All Registered candidates old and new will be allowed to login after accepting the terms and conditions of SPOT Round II.
- iv) There will be no "FREEZE/FLOAT" option in SPOT Round II Counselling, the seat allocated in SPOT Round II Counselling will be FINAL.
- v) The candidates who have reported at their respective School of Studies/Colleges/Institution after seat allocation upto SPOT Round I, if participating in the Spot Round II are assured that if any of the new preferences filled in the Spot Round II Counseling is not allocated to them, their existing allocation of seat shall be retained and shall not change.
- vi) The candidates who have reported at their respective School of Studies/Colleges/Institution after seat allocation upto SPOT Round I, if participating in the Spot Round II and if any of the new preferences filled is allocated to them in the Spot Round II of Counseling then, the candidate has to abide to take the new allocated seat and they will not have any claim on the previous seat.

** Adjustment of Part Academic Fee in SPOT ROUND II of Online Counselling:

All NATA 2022 & JEE 2022 qualified candidates who have been allotted seat in the previous rounds of Online Counselling and had paid the Part Academic Fee of Rs. 40,000/- and wish to participate in the Spot Round II of Counselling, their part Academic Fee of Rs. 40,000/- (Rupees Forty Thousand only) paid in the earlier rounds of Online Counselling will be adjusted during the Spot Round II of Online Counselling. Such candidates, if allotted a seat in the SPOT ROUND II of Online Counselling need not pay the Part Academic Fee of Rs. 40,000/- again.

The following candidates need not to pay again the Part Academic Fee of Rs. 40,000/- (Rupees Forty Thousand Only) during admission in SPOT ROUND II of Online Counselling (i.e. if a seat is allotted in the Spot Round II of Counselling):

- i) A candidate, who was allotted a seat in any round of Online Counselling including Spot Round I and paid the Part Academic Fee and Reported.
- ii) A candidate, who was allotted seat in online round of Online Counselling including Spot Round I, paid the Part Academic Fee but did not report in the allotted institute.
- iii) Any candidate, who was admitted in any round of Online Counselling including Spot Round I, paid the Part Academic Fee and subsequently withdrawn as per procedure.

IX) Withdrawal and Fee Refund after online Rounds of Counselling:

a) After depositing of Academic Fees, if a candidate wants to withdraw the admission against the allotted seat, he/she can apply for withdrawal by clicking on the withdrawal option available in his/her account in the admission website within the specified time period, following the online withdrawal procedure.

b) All candidates who have withdrawn, freezed their seat, not paid the Part Academic Fee of Rs. 40,000/- and who do not fulfill the eligibility criteria, will not be participating in the subsequent round of online counselling and the vacancies with respect to such candidates will be considered for allotment of seat in subsequent Rounds.

X) Reporting of candidates to the allotted institute/college:

- i) After declaration of result of SPOT Round II of Online Counselling, the candidates allotted seat, have to report to the allocated University School/Institutions for verification of documents and payment of balance Part Academic Fee as per the Offer letter of result of Spot Round II of Online Counselling.
- ii) After allotment of seat in the Spot Round II of Counselling, the candidate, if allotted a seat/retained the seat from earlier allotment/upgraded to higher choices/preferences, and if he/she has made the payment of Part Academic Fee of Rs. 40,000/- (if not paid earlier), can generate Provisional Admission Slip.
- iii) Proof of payment of Part Academic Fee receipt of Rs. 40,000/- is available in the candidate's profile.
- iv) The candidates are required to report and join the respective School/College with the Provisional Allotment Letter and the necessary record for verification of documents at the School/institution/college and pay the balance amount of fees (if any), as per the schedule notified on the website, failing which the admission shall be automatically cancelled.
- v) All admissions shall be provisional till regularized by the University.
- vi) Candidates who report to the allotted institutions and are reflected in the list submitted by the institutions as reported/admitted, shall be called "admitted students".

vii) Documents required at the time of reporting to the allotted USS/Institute/College:

The following documents are required at the time of Reporting:

- a) Four passport sized photographs (same as that in admit card)
- b) NATA 2022/ JEE Score/Rank Card.
- c) Proof of date of birth (Secondary School Mark-sheet & Certificate) (Original and Photocopy)
- d) Mark-sheets / Certificates of qualifying examination:
- e) The candidate will be required to bring the Original certificates/Mark-sheets of all the year wise or semester wise in original along with photocopy of Certificates/ Mark-sheets of qualifying examination.
- f) For Distance / Open Learning Cases: In case of students who have passed the qualifying examination through distance / open education system of any recognized University / Board / Institution, the necessary documentary evidence related to location of his / her study centre i.e. study centre proof, certificate from the University imparting open / distance education certifying the location of the study centre to be submitted.

- i) Reserved Category Certificate: All reservation category candidates who are seeking admission in reserved category in SC / ST / DEF / PWD must bring their reservation certificate in original along with the self attested photocopy of the certificate for claiming seat against the reserved category. The Defence Category/ Category candidates, in addition to all the documents, shall also bring relevant Appendix duly completed. The appendices are available in Part E of Admission Brochure 2022-23.
- j) Conduct and Character Certificate in original from the Head of the Institution from where the qualifying examination has been passed or from Gazetted officer in Original, not more than 06 (six) months old.
- k) Application regarding age or any other relaxation with necessary approval (if necessary).
- 1) The required Certificate(s) for reserved categories / classes will be essential at the time of the counselling / admission and no provisional admission shall be admissible for want of caste/category certificate from the local competent authority. Further, the caste / category certificate should invariably be in the name of the candidate himself / herself and not in favour of respective parents / guardians.
- m) Proof of payment of Part Academic Fee Payment receipt of Rs.40,000/- will be available in candidates profile.

Attached herewith is a Notice F.No. GGSIPU/Accts/Bank/2022-23 dated 14.09.2022 titled "Online Collection of Various Fees" providing links for Balance Academic Fee to be submitted by the candidate admitted in University School of Studies through counselling during the Academic Session 2022-23

Office of Dean of University School of Studies shall verify all the documents and credentials of the admitted candidates to ensure correctness of the seat so allotted to him/her and then advise the candidate to submit the Balance Academic Fee through the link provided in the aforesaid notice. The candidate shall download the Fee Receipt of Balance Academic Fee and submit to their respective Office of Dean of University School of Studies to complete Student Admission File in University School of Studies.

XI) Important Note:-

- a) There will be no "FREEZE/FLOAT" option in SPOT Round II Counselling, the seat allocated in SPOT Round II Counselling will be FINAL.
- b) Admitted Candidates who are allotted an upgraded seat in the Spot Round Counselling needs to pay an additional amount of Rs. 5000/- at the newly allotted University School/Affiliated College.
- c) The upgraded candidates have to pay the balance amount of fees (if any), at the newly allotted college/institute/University School. The balance fee paid by such candidates in their previously allotted/reported college/institute shall be refunded to them by the respective college/institute with immediate effect.
- d) <u>In Affiliated Colleges/Institutes of GGSIPU</u>: The balance amount of fees may be submitted through both Online (Net Banking/ Credit Card/ Debit Card) and Offline (through Demand Draft) as per the instructions issued by the respective Affiliated College/Institute.
- e) The Dean/Director/Principal will be responsible to ensure that the eligibility of all the students are checked by them to ensure correctness of admission specially in case of provisionally admitted students.
