The application should reach to the Office of the Programme Coordinator, NSS Cell, GGSIPU & NCC Division at E-209, E-Block, GGSIP University, Sector-16C, Dwarka, New Delhi-110078 **latest by 23.11.2022**.

Terms and conditions of CTO

Faculty offering himself for appointment as an officer shall be appointed as such officer:-

1. Unless she is of good character.
2. Unless she is a citizen of India or a subject of Nepal. Provided that the Central Government may, in any suitable case relax the provisions of this clause.
3. Unless she satisfied that following requirements regarding her age:
 - 1) In the case of an appointment to the Senior Division of the Corps, she has attained the age of 21 years and has not attained the age of 32 years.
 - 2) In the case of an appointment to the Junior Division of the Corps, she has attained the age of 21 years and has not attained the age of 32 years.
4. Unless she satisfied such standard of physical fitness in height, chest measurement and other respects as may be specified by the Ministry of Defence, Government of India.
5. Unless she is a permanent member of the teaching staff of a college with a minimum of 3 years' service as a regular lecturer or she is regular member of the teaching staff of a school with 3 years' service may be relaxed by the Director General National Cadet Corps and they may be appointed even earlier.
6. If she has at any time been convicted of an offence involving moral turpitude and a sentence other than that of fine or imprisonment in default of payment of fine has been passed in respect of such offences, such sentence not having been subsequently reversed or remitted or the offence pardoned.
7. If she has been dismissed from the University Corps of the Indian Territorial Force or the National Cadet Corps or the Territorial Army or the Indian Armed Forces.
8. If she is a member of any organization of the nature, specified in paragraph 1 of Schedule III, provided that-
 - a. In case of an officer discharged from the University Corps from the University Corps of the Indian Territorial Force the Ministry of Defence, Government of India, may relax the age limit prescribed by clause (b).
 - b. A person who is ineligible under clause (e) shall be eligible for appointment if he produces a certificate from the State Government that she is a fit person to be appointed.
 - c. The Ministry of Defence, Government of India, may authorize the appointment of any person who is not qualified for appointment under rule.
