Admissions Criteria:

1. GATE qualified applicants will get first preference –the candidate should have qualified in the relevant discipline with a valid score card of GATE.
2. Non-GATE Candidates will be shortlisted based on a merit list prepared by the University based on the average percentage in the qualifying exam.

Note:

- The merit list may change subject to verification of GATE Score Card and other information from the original documents / marks sheet at the time of counselling.
- Allotment of Seat will stop as and when the seats get filled up.
- The counselling will be subject to availability of vacant seats if any and in any category.

Important:

- A candidate belonging to any sub-category is also eligible to secure admission in General / Unreserved Category of his / her respective Region, purely on the merit of CET.
- The conversion of seats reserved for SC, ST, OBC, Minority, etc. to General Category shall be done only after the completion of last Round of Counselling for the reserved categories and no such conversion will be allowed during the 1st Round of Counselling. However, while converting the seats, any unfilled seat(s) reserved for ST Category will be offered to SC Category and vice versa and only after that the conversion of the reserved category seats shall be effected.
- **Allotment of Seats will stop as and when the seats get filled up.**
- The Counselling for the seats reserved for any region / category shall be stopped as and when the seats in / of such category / region are filled up.

2. **Seat Allocation in Delhi and Outside Delhi Region**

3. **Reservation Policy**

Candidates shall refer to the Chapter 6: 'Reservation Policy', Admission Brochure 2024-25.

4. **Eligibility Criteria for Programme M.Tech (Nano Technology), CET Code-149**

Minimum 55% or equivalent in the qualifying examinations:

M.Sc.(Physics / Applied Physics / Electronics/ Mathematics / Chemistry / Biotechnology / Biosciences/ Life Sciences/ Material Science; B.E./B.Tech (Electronics / Computer Science / Electrical / Mechanical / Engineering Physics / Metallurgy / Material Engineering / Information Technology / Biotechnology / Biomedical / Chemical Engineering or Technology); or equivalent and Mathematics as one of the subjects at 10+2 or undergraduate level is a must.

5. **Fees:**

Bank Draft(s) of Rs. 1,56,500/- (Including Rs. 1,000/- Counselling Processing Fee (one time non-refundable) in favour of Registrar, **Guru Gobind Singh Indraprastha University, payable at Delhi**. The candidate will write his/her name, date of admission, phone, address, mobile no, name of the programme on the back of the Bank Draft(s).Balance fee (if applicable) shall be paid by the candidate at the venue of the Counselling. The eligible Candidates in their own interest are advised to get their draft prepared well in advance to avoid last time inconvenience.

6. **Documents Required for Verification and Allotment of Seats:**

- a) Bank Draft(s) of **Rs. 1,56,500** (Including Rs. 1,000/- Counselling Processing Fee (one time non-refundable) in favour of **Registrar, Guru Gobind Singh Indraprastha University, payable at Delhi**. The candidate will write his name, Application No., date of admission, phone, address, mobile no, name of the programme on the back of the Bank Draft(s).

- b) Four passport sized photographs (same as that in admit card)
- c) Qualified and Valid GATE Score Card (Original), if applicable.
- d) Experience Certificate (original), if applicable.
- e) Copy of Admission verification form (Copy of Admission verification form as per Appendix 6 in Part F of Admission Brochure 2024-25.)
- f) Proof of date of birth (Secondary School Mark-sheet & Certificate) (Original and Photocopy)
- g) Mark-sheets / Certificates of qualifying examination:
The candidate will be required to bring the Original certificates / Mark-sheets of all the year wise or semester wise in original along with photocopy of Certificates / Mark-sheets of qualifying examination. (In case of CGPA, please bring certificate containing formula for conversion from CGPA to percentage).
- h) Physical Fitness Certificate:
All the students shall be required to submit a Medical Certificate indicating fitness from a Registered Medical Practitioner as per format given in Performa of Medical Certificate in given in Part-F in Admission Brochure 2024-25 (As per Appendix 5).
- j). Reserved Category Certificate:
All reservation category candidates who are seeking admission in reserved category in UR&EWS/ SC / ST / DEF/ PWD must bring their reservation certificate in original along with the self attested photocopy of the certificate for claiming seat against the reserved category. The Defence Category candidates, in addition, shall also bring Appendix 1 duly completed. The Appendices are available in Part F of Admission Brochure 2024-25.
- k). Conduct and Character Certificate in original from the Head of the Institution from where the qualifying examination has been passed or from Gazetted officer in Original, not more than 06 (six) months old.
- l). Application regarding age or any other relaxation with necessary approval (if necessary).
- m). The candidate claiming reservation against UR&EWS category must produce certificate issued by the Competent Authority at the time of verification of documents and allotment of seat.

7 **Instructions to be followed at the time of 2nd counseling 2024-25**

- a) The students, who have been admitted during 1st counseling in any category, will not be allowed to change their category in 2nd Counselling.
- b) The Second Counselling will commence from rank one onwards for all categories / programmes and the seats will be allotted strictly on the basis of merit of the candidates. **Such candidates, who were absent in the First Counselling will also be permitted to attend the second counselling.**
- c) A candidate who fails to appear in person on the notified date and time for counselling, shall forfeit his/her claim for the seat which could be offered to him/her, had he/she been present on his/her turn. However, if the candidate reports late or reports on subsequent days during the process of counselling,

he/she may be considered for allotment of a seat available at that point of time provided he/she had not taken admission earlier.

d) **The conversion of seats reserved for SC, ST, DEF, PWD etc.** to General Category shall be done only after completion of 2nd round of counselling for the reserved category in case of offline counselling. However, while converting the seats during 2nd round of counselling, any unfilled seat(s) reserved for ST Category will be offered first to SC Category and vice versa and only after completing this exercise, the conversion of the reserved category seats to general category shall be effected.

e) **De-reservation of unfilled Outside Delhi Quota Seats to Delhi Quota and Vice versa:**

In the Offline Counselling, Seats reserved for Outside Delhi Category will be converted to Delhi Category and Vice versa for the programmes for which offline counseling will be done during the **Open House Counselling** (which will only be held if seats are vacant after 2nd Round of Counselling has been completed in the respective region). Thereafter, seats remaining vacant shall be converted into general category.

8. **Seat Matrix:** To be displayed at the time of counselling.


9. **Open House Counselling:**

Open House Counselling / spot counselling: Counselling on the Open Day will be held only if any seat(s) remains vacant after two rounds of counselling. The said seat(s) will be offered on that day to the qualified candidate(s) in order of merit. The seat(s) shall be offered to the qualified candidate(s) in order of merit irrespective of his/her Region provided he/she has reported for counselling on that day. A counselling processing fee of Rs. 1000/- shall have to be paid by all eligible candidates to participate in the open house counselling.

NOTE: The candidate who has withdrawn after 1st round of counseling will be allowed to take admission during **Open House Counselling**.

Terms and condition will remain same as notified in the Admission Brochure 2024-25.
