Important:

- A candidate belonging to any sub-category is also eligible to secure admission in General/Unreserved Category, purely on the merit of GAT-B 2024 score.
- Allotment of Seats will stop as and when the seats get filled up.

Reservation Policy

Candidates shall please refer to Government of India guidelines

Eligibility Criteria for Programme M.Tech (Industrial Biotechnology)

Candidates are required to have a B.Tech. (Biotechnology/Chemical Engg/ Biochemical Engg/or related field), B. Pharma or MSc (in Biotechnology/Biochemistry or related field of life and natural sciences) with a minimum of 60% (General, EWS & OBC category) or 55% (SC,ST & PwD) marks.

Documents Required for Verification and Allotment of Seats:

- a) Bank Draft(s) of Rs. 60,500/- (Sixty thousand five hundred ONLY) Academic Fee plus Rs 1000/- (Non-Refundable) towards Counselling Participation Fee (a total of Rs. 61,500/-) is required at the time counselling in favour of Registrar, Guru Gobind Singh Indraprastha University, payable at Delhi.

Break up of Academic fees:

Tuition (per annum):	Rs. 25,000/-
University's charges/Share (per annum):	Rs. 20,000/-
Alumni contribution (one time payment):	Rs. 2,000/-
Examination Fee per student (per annum):	Rs. 3,000/-
Innovation & Incubation Fee (per annum):	Rs. 500/-
Development and Infrastructural Charges (per annum):	Rs. 10,000/-

The candidate will write his/her name, date of admission, phone, address, mobile no., name of the programme, GAT-B Score/Rank and GAT-B Roll Number on the back of the Bank Draft(s).

- b) Four passport sized photographs (same as that in admit card)
- c) Qualified and Valid GAT-B 2024 Score Card (Original and Photocopy).
- d) Copy of Admission verification form (as per Appendix 6 in Part F of Admission Brochure 2024-25).
- e) Proof of date of birth (Secondary School Mark-sheet & Certificate) (Original and Photocopy)
- f) Mark-sheets / Certificates of qualifying examination:
The candidate will be required to bring the Original certificates / Mark-sheets of all the year wise or semester wise in original along with photocopy of Certificates / Mark-sheets of qualifying examination.
- g) Physical Fitness Certificate:
All the students shall be required to submit a Medical Certificate indicating fitness from a Registered Medical Practitioner as per format given in Performa of Medical Certificate in given in Part-F in Admission Brochure 2024-25 (As per Appendix 5).
- h). Reserved Category Certificate:
All reservation category candidates who are seeking admission in reserved category in UR&EWS/SC/ST/OBC-NCL/PWD must bring their reservation certificate in original along with the self attested photocopy of the certificate for claiming seat against the reserved category. The Appendices are available in Part F of Admission Brochure 2024-25. **EWS Certificate should be issued after 31st March, 2024 stating valid for year 2024-2025.**
- i). Conduct and Character Certificate in original from the Head of the Institution from where the qualifying examination has been passed or from Gazetted officer in Original, not more than 06 (six) months old.
- j). Application regarding age or any other relaxation with necessary approval (if necessary).

- k). The candidate claiming reservation against UR&EWS category must produce certificate issued by the Competent Authority at the time of verification of documents and allotment of seat.
