** Adjustment of Part Academic Fee in SPOT ROUND of Online Counselling:

All CET 2023/ CLAG PG 2023 qualified candidates who have been allotted seat in the previous rounds of Online Counselling and had paid the Part Academic Fee of Rs. 60,000/- and wish to participate in the Spot Round of Counselling, their part Academic Fee of Rs. 60,000/- (Rupees Sixty Thousand only) paid in the earlier rounds of Online Counselling will be adjusted during the Spot Round of Online Counselling. Such candidates, if allotted a seat in the SPOT ROUND of Online Counselling need not pay the Part Academic Fee of Rs. 60,000/- again.

The following candidates need not to pay again the Part Academic Fee of Rs. 60,000/- (Rupees Sixty Thousand Only) during admission in SPOT ROUND of Online Counselling (i.e. if a seat is allotted in the Spot Round of Counselling):

i) A candidate, who was allotted a seat in any round of Online Counselling and paid the Part Academic Fee and Reported.

ii) A candidate, who was allotted seat in online round of Online Counselling, paid the Part Academic Fee but did not report in the allotted institute.

iii) Any candidate, who was admitted in any round of Online Counselling, paid the Part Academic Fee and subsequently withdrawn as per procedure.

(V) Spot Round Procedure:

- i) Enrolment for participation for SPOT Round will be for all <u>CLAT PG 2023 (For LLM), CET 2023 [For M.A. (English) & M.A. (Economics)]</u> qualified candidates irrespective of his/her registration earlier.
- ii) All Registered candidates old and new will be allowed to login after accepting the terms and conditions of SPOT Round.
- iii) The candidates who have reported at their respective School of Studies/Colleges/Institution after seat allocation upto 3rd/ Sliding Round, if participating in the Spot Round are assured that if any of the new preferences filled in the Spot Counseling is not allocated to them, their existing allocation of seat shall be retained and shall not change.
- iv) The candidates who have reported at their respective School of Studies/Colleges/Institution after seat allocation upto 3rd/ Sliding Round, if participating in the Spot Round and if any of the new preferences filled is allocated to them in the Spot Round of Counseling then, the candidate has to abide to take the new allocated seat and they will not have any claim on the previous seat.

(VI) GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS:

- (a) The candidates must read the conditions of eligibility for admission as given in the Admission Brochure for 2023-24 carefully and must satisfy themselves regarding their eligibility for admission in various programmes before registering online for admission and submitting the Counselling Participation Fees.
- (b) It is the sole responsibility of the candidate to ensure that they fulfill the minimum eligibility criteria in the programmes they seek admission; the correctness of the details filled with respect to region; category or any other such details for allotment of seat. If at any stage of admission procedure the information furnished by the candidate is found to be incorrect or false the admission to the programme shall be cancelled and all the fees paid will be forfeited.

- (c) In order to avoid last minute rush, the candidates are advised to apply early enough. The University will not be responsible for network problems or any other problem of such nature for either submission of online application or any other activity during the last minute.
- (d) Candidates claiming seat in Delhi "Region" must have passed the qualifying examination (i.e.10+2/Graduation) from any of the institutes/ Colleges located in Delhi. Allotment of seats in wrong region on account of incorrect filling of form will lead to cancellation of the allotment at any later stage and candidate will automatically lose the right to the seat in his bonafied region if not available at the time of cancellation of seat.

(VII) IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS FOR CANDIDATES CLAIMING RESERVATION:-

- (a) The candidate seeking admission under reserved categories have to mandatorily upload the entitled supporting certificate in his/her name. The Candidates for further details must read Chapter 6 (Reservation Policy of Admission Brochure 2023-24.
- (b) The reservation certificate should be issued from the respective state under the "Region" in which the reservation is claimed.
- (c) In case the candidate is claiming the seat reserved for DOBC/DSC/DST category then He/ She should have passed his/ her qualifying exam from Delhi School/College and must have OBC/SC/ST certificate issued by the Competent Authority of Govt. of NCT of Delhi only.
- (d) Reservation in OBC Category is not applicable for Master's Level and Postgraduate Diploma programmes. Refer Admission Brochure for more information.
- (e) The Reservation for <u>EWS</u> category is applicable only in University School of Studies and Govt. affiliated Colleges only. This will be implemented in accordance with the Govt. of India and Govt. of NCT of Delhi orders as applicable. EWS Certificate should be issued after 31st March, 2023 stating valid for year 2023-2024.
- (f) For claiming reservation on a seat reserved for <u>DEFENCE</u> Category, the candidate have to upload the duly filled and signed **Appendix 1** of Admission Brochure 2023-24 by the competent authority.
- (g) Reserve Category Candidates who fail either to upload documents as per notified schedule or whose documents are not in order will forfeit his/her right for the reserve category claimed and will automatically be converted to General Category as per University rules.

(VIII) CHOICE FILLING/EDITING:

- 1. Choice filling is compulsory for allotment of seat. Candidate will not be considered for online allotment of seat without the filled in choices/preferences.
- 2. After registration, candidate has to fill choices for allotment, from the list of all possible combinations of all institutes and courses available, in the order of his/her preference, during the choice filling period.
- 3. Once the period for filling of choices/preferences is over, choices/preferences filled by candidate will be used for allotment of seat.
- 4. Candidates are advised and encouraged in their own interest to fill maximum number of choices, as it increases the possibility of getting the desirable seat. For the benefit of the candidates, the stream wise and institute-wise and rankwise Admission Rank cut off data is available on University Website and as relevant link in https://ipu.admissions.nic.in.

- 5. From previous experiences, it has been noted that some candidates fill up very few / limited number of choices, may result in non allotment of seat during seat allotment. Therefore it is once again advised that the candidates should fill as many choices as possible to ensure that they have better chances of allotment of seat.
- 6. Candidates, however, will be given the opportunity to edit/modify/add/delete preferences after allotment of seat in Round 01 for the subsequent rounds of counselling.
- 7. The candidates are also advised to fill choices/preferences, then save the same and then take the print out of the saved choices/preferences to be retained for future reference.

(IX) WITHDRAWAL AND FEE REFUND AFTER ONLINE ROUNDS OF COUNSELLING:

- 1. After depositing of Academic Fees, if a candidate wants to withdraw the admission against the allotted seat, he/she can apply for withdrawal by clicking on the withdrawal option available in his/her account in the admission website within the specified time period, following the online withdrawal procedure.
- 2. All candidates who have withdrawn, freezed their seat, not paid the Part Academic Fee of Rs. 60,000/- and who do not fulfill the eligibility criteria, will not be participating in the subsequent round of online counselling and the vacancies with respect to such candidates will be considered for allotment of seat in subsequent Rounds.

(X) Reporting of candidates to the allotted Institute/College/USS:

- i) After declaration of result of SPOT Round of Online Counselling, the candidates allotted seat, have to report to the allocated University School/Institutions for verification of documents and payment of balance Part Academic Fee as per the Offer letter of result of Spot Round of Online Counselling.
- ii) After allotment of seat in the Spot Round of Counselling, the candidate, if allotted a seat/retained the seat from earlier allotment/upgraded to higher choices/preferences, and if he/she has made the payment of Part Academic Fee of Rs. 60,000/- (if not paid earlier), can generate Provisional Admission Slip.
- iii) Proof of payment of Part Academic Fee receipt of Rs. 60,000/- is available in the candidate's profile.
- iv) The candidates are required to report and join the respective School/College with the Provisional Allotment Letter and the necessary record for verification of documents at the School/institution/college and pay the balance amount of fees (if any), as per the schedule notified on the website, failing which the admission shall be automatically cancelled.
- v) All admissions shall be provisional till regularized by the University.
- vi) Result Awaited candidates may please see the provisions contained in the Admission Brochure 2023-24.
- vii) Candidates who report to the allotted institutions and are reflected in the list submitted by the institutions as reported/admitted, shall be called "admitted students".

- d) Mark-sheets / Certificates of qualifying examination:
- e) The candidate will be required to bring the Original certificates/Mark-sheets of all the year wise or semester wise in original along with photocopy of Certificates/ Mark-sheets of qualifying examination.
- f) For Distance / Open Learning Cases:

In case of students who have passed the qualifying examination through distance / open education system of any recognized University / Board / Institution, the necessary documentary evidence related to location of his / her study centre i.e. study centre proof, certificate from the University imparting open / distance education certifying the location of the study centre to be submitted.

- g) Physical Fitness Certificate:
 - All the students shall be required to submit a Medical Certificate indicating fitness from a Registered Medical Practitioner as per format given in Performa of Medical Certificate given in Admission Brochure 2023-24.
- h) Copy of Online Reserved Categories verification slip.
- i) Reserved Category Certificate:
 - All reservation category candidates who are seeking admission in reserved category in SC / ST / DEF / PWD/ / KM must bring their reservation certificate in original along with the self attested photocopy of the certificate for claiming seat against the reserved category. The Defence Category candidates, in addition to all the documents, shall also bring Appendix 1 duly completed. The appendices are available in Admission Brochure 2023-24.
- j) Conduct and Character Certificate in original from the Head of the Institution from where the qualifying examination has been passed or from Gazetted officer in Original, not more than 06 (six) months old.
- k) Application regarding age or any other relaxation with necessary approval (if necessary).
- 1) The required Certificate(s) for reserved categories / classes will be essential at the time of the counselling / admission and no provisional admission shall be admissible for want of caste/category certificate from the local competent authority. Further, the caste / category certificate should invariably be in the name of the candidate himself / herself and not in favour of respective parents / guardians.
- m) Respective USS and all affiliated colleges shall ensure that the candidate(s) who are claiming seats in the particular reserved category must have valid certificate to substantiate their claim towards allotment of that particular reserved category seats.
- n) Proof of payment of Part Academic Fee Payment receipt of Rs.60,000/ will be available in candidates profile.
- o) Details of Balance Academic Fee to be paid at the time of reporting:

(i) In various University School of Studies:

The balance amount of fees may be submitted through both Online (Net Banking/ Credit Card/ Debit Card) and Offline (through Demand Draft) as per the instructions issued by the respective Affiliated College/Institute.

p) Important Note:

- a) Admitted Candidates who are allotted an upgraded seat in the Spot Round of Counselling needs to pay an additional amount of Rs. 5000/- at the newly allotted University School/Affiliated College.
- b) The upgraded candidates have to pay the balance amount of fees (if any), at the newly allotted college/institute/University School. The balance fee paid by such candidates in their previously allotted/reported college/institute shall be refunded to them by the respective college/institute with immediate effect.
- c) In Affiliated Colleges/Institutes of GGSIPU: The balance amount of fees may be submitted through both Online (Net Banking/ Credit Card/ Debit Card) and Offline (through Demand Draft) as per the instructions issued by the respective Affiliated College/Institute.

- h) Seats left vacant, if any, after spot counselling only shall be considered for admission process of filling up of vacancies for the admission year as per the policy of the University.
