- (ii) An eminent Scholar having a Ph.D. Degree in the concerned/allied/relevant discipline, and published work of high quality, actively engaged in research with evidence of published work with, a minimum of 10 research publications in the peer-reviewed or UGC-listed journals/Indexed journals (preferably in Scopus/Web of Science/Thomson Reuters) and a total research score of 120 as per the criteria given in appendix-II Table 2 of UGC Regulations dated: 18/07/2018.
- (iii) A Minimum of ten years of teaching experience in university/college as Assistant Professor/Associate Professor/Professor, and/or research experience at equivalent level at the University/National Level Institutions with evidence of having successfully guided doctoral candidate.
- (iv) Registered with State Pharmacy Council.

- 4. All applicants who are presently employed in Government/Semi Govt./Public Sector Undertaking/University/Recognized Educational Institute etc. should apply through proper channel enclosing a certificate from the Government organization stating no Vigilance or Disciplinary case is pending or contemplated against them and also submit a no objection certificate from present employer. Failure to provide the same shall make them ineligible for consideration to the post(s). Application received late shall not be entertained and delay in transit shall be the responsibility of applicant.
- 5. The educational qualification, age, experience and other conditions of eligibility as stipulated above against the post shall be determined as on the closing date of receipt of applications.
- 6. Fulfillment of conditions of minimum qualification shall not necessarily entitle any applicant to be called for further process of recruitment.
- 7. Application Form must also be accompanied by attested copies of all Educational and Professional Qualifications, Experience Certificates. An application, without the said documents is likely to be rejected during the course of screening.
- 8. In case of large number of applicants, University reserves the right to shortlist applicants in any manner as may be considered appropriate and no reason for rejection shall be communicated.
- 9. The shortlisted candidate will be called for Document Verification on scheduled date and time as informed by the University on University website as well as through e-mail. At the time of Document Verification, candidates should carry all their original documents and testimonials for verification along with a hardcopy of duly filled-in application form submitted in online mode with a copy of all educational qualifications, reprints of research publications, teaching/working experience certificates/last pay drawn etc. for submission.
