INSTITUTION OF NIRMAL GOPAL MEMORIAL AWARDS

The Directorate of Students' Welfare has instituted the 'Nirmal Gopal Memorial Awards' for the students of the University in two categories, i.e., 'Academic' and 'Sports'. These awards are funded from the interest income generated from the contribution of Rs. 10.00 lakhs made by Prof. Promila Gupta, USBT, GGSIPU in memory of her parents.

The awards will be presented annually at the University Convocation and Sports Meet respectively. This initiative has been approved in pursuance of the decisions of the Finance Committee in its 71st meeting held on 26.09.2025 and the Board of Management in its 89th meeting held on 01.10.2025.

1. Academic

PwD Category student who has secured highest merit in the first year of B.Com(H) programme of the GGSIP University will be awarded with an amount of Rs.31,000/- (Thirty one thousand) and if PwD Category is not found then the students from the Economically Weaker student be awarded on the same criteria.

2. Sports

Two students as Athlete of the year (one male and one female) of the GGSIP University for their performances in the previous year, i.e., starting on 1st April and ending on 31st March in the year of award, in the sports that are currently part of the Olympic Games/Paralympics/Asian Games/Asian Para Games/Commonwealth Games for their performances in the GGSIPU Inter-Collegiate, AIU Zonal/All India Inter-University, National Championships, National Games, Commonwealth Championship, Asian Championship, World Championship, Olympic Games, Paralympics Games to be awarded with a Scholarship of Rs.11,000/- (Eleven thousand only) each (Guidelines are attached)

1. Only certificates of such sports/events/weight categories as are presently included in the Olympic Games, Paralympic Games, Asian Games, Asian Para Games, Commonwealth Games, or Commonwealth Games (Para Athletes) shall be deemed valid and shall accordingly be taken into consideration for evaluation. Certificates relating to any other sport/event/weight category/competition, whether at the international, national, university, or inter-collegiate level, shall under no circumstances be considered for evaluation or the award.
2. The award is exclusively for Students Enrolled in GGSIP University (University School of Studies & Centre/Affiliated Colleges/Institutions).
3. Only certificates of sports competitions that commenced between 1st April of the previous year and 31st March of the award year will be considered for evaluation.
4. Letter /letter head of participation/merit certificates will not be considered for evaluation.
5. Certificates of Invitational / Memorial / Prize Money / League Matches / Selection Trials / Ranking Competitions will not be considered for evaluation.
6. Certificates with cuttings, overwriting, or incomplete details will not be considered for evaluated.
7. The Athletes sanctioned under doping offences will not be eligible for award.
8. The Directorate of Students' Welfare (DSW), GGSIPU shall issue a notification inviting applications for the award.
9. The DSW may prescribe a minimum marks criteria for applying.
10. Applications must be submitted within the notified deadline along with all required documents, duly verified by the concerned USS/Centre/Affiliated Institutions.
11. Total marks of all valid certificates earned during the evaluation period will be considered for calculating the marks.
12. In case of tie in marks, the following will decide the winner:
 - a. Higher category of competition.
 - b. If still tied - elder in age.
 - c. If still tied - a draw will be conducted by the DSW Office in the presence of the applicants.
13. Separate awards will be given for Best Male Athlete and Best Female Athlete of the Year.
14. The award shall consist of a cash prize of Rs. 11,000/- each (One Male & One Female)
15. A Scrutiny Committee shall be constituted by DSW for scrutinize and marking/evaluation of applications.
16. The decision of the DSW in all matters regarding the award will be final and binding.
