

College/School Campus Drives & Formation of Anti-Drugs Clubs:-

13. It was apprised to the Chair that in coordination with the education department during Pilot Project of 'Drugs Free Delhi' in December-2024, many awareness activities were organized in entire Delhi, including displaying awareness videos through Jan Sampark Vahan of Delhi Police, at various locations, particularly near schools, colleges. Pubs/bars, hot-spots, pan-shops & cluster areas to make an impact on the new generation. During this campaign, posters, pamphlets, stickers etc. were also distributed in jhuggi / cluster area particularly at hot-spots. Moreover, such videos were also shared through social media platforms of Delhi Police.

13.1 Seminars were organized in schools of Delhi Govt., NDMC & colleges in different areas of Delhi to further promote awareness. School Awareness Programs conducted in 29 Zones in collaboration with the Education Department. In other awareness activities, 101 events held with a total of 18,955 participants.

13.2 The Chair further directed to create a Standard Operating Procedure (SOP)/Circular for conducting awareness drives in educational institutions, hot-spots and cluster areas, in coordination with ANTF (Anti-Narcotics Task Force), NCB (Narcotics Control Bureau), and Departments of Social Welfare and Education, GNCTD.

13.3 Delhi Police has started Anti-Drug Clubs establishment in Rohini Distt. As pilot project and Education Department is also in process of making proper guidelines for formation of the clubs & committees, their structure and prizes etc.

13.4 It was directed to make Anti-Drugs Clubs in all the educational institutions and Principals of Colleges & Directors of Education, should be actively involved in this process. The District Level Committee also needs to be made to supervise the working of these clubs. He suggested that one-year period may be given for declaring any college or campus as a Drug-Free Campus, if no such cases are reported during that time and also to come out with an incentive mechanism for the best performing colleges/clubs.

13.5 It was apprised by the Excise Department that action is being taken against the violators. It has been noticed that minors are going and drinking in clubs/bars. There should be a surprise check and the license of such outlets be got cancelled forthwith and detailed outcome reports be submitted.
