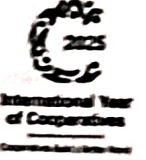

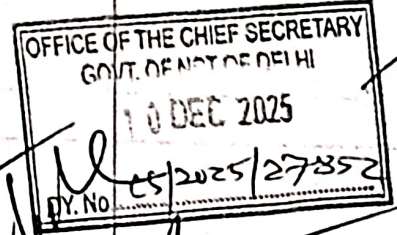

Indicative list of Proposed Activities for various institutions in the States/UTs (including pre-schools/early childhood education centres, primary, secondary and higher secondary schools, colleges, universities, Child Care Institutions, Anganwadi Centres, Special Schools for children with disabilities, Children's Homes, Observation Homes, orphanages, youth clubs and community learning centres, sports facilities etc.) **to Celebrate Veer Baal Diwas**

1. Competitions by Age Group:

a. **Pre-Primary level (3-6 years):** Drawing/Painting, sports activities, story-telling etc.

b. **Primary Level (6-10 years):** Painting, essay writing, and storytelling on topics such as:

- My Dream for India
- The India I Want to See
- My Superpower to Help Others
- Colours of My Culture
- Heroes Around Me (teachers, caregivers, friends)

c. **Secondary Level (11-18 years):** Essays, poems, debates, and digital presentations on topics such as:

- Role of Children in Nation Building
- My Vision for a Developed India
- Children's Role in Shaping Viksit Bharat
- Courage and Compassion: What Makes a Hero?
- Stories of Valour from India's History
- Digital India – Opportunities for Youth
- Swachh Bharat, Swasth Bharat
- Beti Bachao Beti Padhao – Empowering Every Girl
- Atmanirbhar Bharat – Youth as Drivers of Innovation
- Vocal for Local – Celebrating India's Traditional Crafts
- Skill India Mission – Preparing Youth for the Future
