## CIRCULAR


**Subject: Celebration of Anti-Ragging Day on 12<sup>th</sup> August, followed by Anti-Ragging Week from 12 to 18<sup>th</sup> August, 2025**

Reference to the email dated: 23<sup>rd</sup> July, 2025 received from University Grant Commission (UGC) regarding prevention of ragging, the UGC has framed regulations of curbing the menace of ragging in Higher Educational Institutions. These regulations are mandatory, and all institutions are required to take necessary steps for its implementation in toto, including monitoring mechanism as per provisions in the above regulations and ensure its strict compliance. The UGC has also taken several proactive steps, including the effective launch of media campaigns and awareness activities for preventing ragging. Videos on anti-ragging are also uploaded on UGC website for use by higher education institutions.

UGC has decided in 2023 that Anti Ragging Day would be observed on 12<sup>th</sup> August, followed by Anti Ragging Week from 12<sup>th</sup> August to 18<sup>th</sup> August, 2025. This initiative is one of the tools of the Commission to increase awareness against ragging. The Higher Educational Institutions are desired to adopt the following activities during the celebration of Anti-Ragging Day/Week:

- i. Inaugural ceremonies to mark the launch of Anti-Ragging Day/Week
- ii. Competitions such as slogan writing, essay writing, poster making, logo designing, street play performance, photography, quiz competition debates, and more on Anti-Ragging themes. Distribute certificates and prizes to encourage the participants to actively promote Anti-Ragging measures.
- iii. Social media campaigns, activity posts, and video message by the head of the institutions to disseminate Anti-Ragging messages on the institution's website and social media platforms.
- iv. Awareness activities like workshops, seminars, interactive sessions, and other creative avenues such as setting up selfie corners on campus to spread the key messages.
- v. Encourage your students to participate in the National Contest 2025 on Digital Posters, Reels, and short videos. Detailed information regarding the National Contest, its categories, deadlines, eligibility, selection, and awards is available at [www.antiragging.in](http://www.antiragging.in)
- vi. Anti-Ragging short films/TVCs may be screened for students and faculty (available on UGC website [www.antiragging.in](http://www.antiragging.in)).
