#### For Award of Diploma:

- 2. Student shall be required to appear in examinations of all courses. However, to award the Degree B.Voc. (Applied Arts) a student shall be required to earn a minimum of 180 credits.

#### FOR LATERAL ENTRY STUDENTS-For Award of Advanced Diploma:

- 1. The total number of the credits of the Diploma (Applied Arts) Programme = 63
- 2. Each student shall be required to appear for examinations in all courses Third Semester onwards. However, for the award of the Degree B.Voc. (Applied Arts) a student shall be required to earn a minimum of 60 credits.

#### FOR LATERAL ENTRY STUDENTS- For Award of B.Voc Degree:

- 1. The total number of the credits of the Diploma (Applied Arts) Programme = 127
- 2. Each student shall be required to appear for examinations in all courses Third Semester onwards. However, for the award of the Degree B.Voc. (Applied Arts) a student shall be required to earn a minimum of 120 credits.
