To consider & approve for Award of Degrees/ Certificates to be conferred in person and in absentia in the Eighth Convocation to students who have successfully qualified for various programmes of the University for the year 2010-2011 and Gold Medals to the toppers.

The members applauded the University for its achievement and congratulated for the eighth convocation and growth in terms of conducting 121 Technical and Professional programmes. It was highlighted that all five candidates were from affiliated institutions and only one student was from the University maintained Indira Gandhi Institute of Technology. Since no student in this category was from any of the Schools of the University, the subject was deliberated at length to discuss the reasons. However, it was suggested to analyse the students' performance data information of internal and external marks so that appropriate interpretation and measures could be taken by the University.

To consider the conferment of Honorary Degree of the Doctor of Philosophy in Engineering & Technology (Honoris Causa) to Sh. Brijmohan Lall Munjal

The members admired the practice of conferment of Hononary Degree of the Doctor of Philosophy to eminent personalities. Last year the same was conferred to Shri Sreedharan, Chairman of Delhi Metro Rail Corporation and this year it was decided to be conferred to Sh. Brijmohan Lall Munjal, Chairman of the Hero Group a techno-savy- visionary. As a great gesture on the part of the University, the Council approved the same.

Agenda Item No.30.05

To consider proposal for constitution for Indraprastha University Industry Institute interaction cell (IUIIIC)

The Council appreciated the efforts of the University to establish interaction/collaboration with the industry in a structured manner and also its effort to ensure revision and improvisation of the course curriculum which is Industry relevant in the form of Indraprastha University Industry Institute interaction cell (IUIIIC).

It was further indicated that the affiliated institutions may also workout similar activity under the aegis and supervision of the University, however, all networking with the corporate agencies will be carried out by them. The University shall provide under special circumstances, financial support in case the arrangement benefits all components and the advisory committee approves of it. The Council approved for the constitution of IUIIIC as proposed.

To consider and approve the proposal of a New Ordinance for establishment of Centres of Excellence in the University

The matter was deliberated at length and the council recognized the value of promoting inter-disciplinary, academic-cum-research based education through Centres of Excellence. It was further discussed that the topics of research at these centres will be in emerging areas and they shall be attracting financial support in the form of research and consultancy projects. After proper growth, these centres may be transformed into a University School in future. The council approved the new Ordinance as proposed.

Agenda Item No.30.07(A):

To consider revised Ordinance – 12 for grant of Degree in Doctor of Philosophy

The Council deliberated at length regarding revised version of Ordinance – 12 and its regulations therein covering modalities and requirements of all programmes leading to Doctor of Philosophy. It was suggested by some of the members that all supervisors including the main supervisor, joint supervisor, co-guide shall write the report of their Ph.D. students as all of them are responsible for completion of the research work. An internal circular/ directive shall also be passed to ensure presence of all supervisors on the occasion of progress report discussions and submission of thesis of their respective student.

The amended Ordinance – 12 captioned 'Governing Programmes leading to Degree of Doctor of Philosophy' and its six regulations had been approved by the Council as proposed.

Agenda Item No.30.07

To consider the date of Ph.D. registration, conduct of course work for the Research Scholars registered from 01.08.2008 to 07.08.2009 (Date of enforcement of Amended Ordinance-12).

The Chairman of the Council explained about the variation which had occurred in pursuance of the course work among the students registered for Ph.D. programme before August 2009 in the University. The matter was deliberated by the members of the Academic Council for a long time. It was decided that no mention

will be made about the course work and its credits in their degree certificates for those Ph.D. students who have not pursued the same while being engaged for the Ph.D. programme. However, for those students who have completed the coursework during the pursuance of their Ph.D. programme, additional mention of such completion of course work would be highlighted in the degree certificate issued to them.

It was unanimously decided by the council that the practice of pursuance of the prescribed course work and earning credits shall be mandatory for all Ph.D. students of the University who have been registered after August, 2009.

It was further decided that a three member committee may be constituted to enquire wherever irregularities have been observed either by the students or the schools. In order to streamline the entire process, it will be compulsory for the students to deposit their dues regarding all fees and it will be the responsibility of the respective Dean to ensure compliance of the same.

To consider and approve regulation for inspection of Answer Sheets 2011 in pursuance of the directions of the Hon'ble Supreme Court

In principle, the Academic Council approved the proposal for the new regulation for inspection of Answer Sheets in pursuance of the directions of the Hon'ble Supreme Court, however, it was decided that the controller of examination should evolve a procedure for the same and get it approved by the Academic Council for its implementation.

It was further decided that the university should impose heavy charges in the form of inspection fee for each answer sheet to check & discourage this practice as the same would unnecessarily add inconvenience to the University.

The proposal was deliberated upon by the members of the Academic Council and it was unanimously decided that an expert committee may be appointed to examine the proposal, its utility, academic value and sustainability issues in the long term before any approval is granted. All members opined that the episode of Delhi University regarding after effects of radio-active pencils used for laboratory purpose should not be ignored.

Thus, the expert committee so constituted will include radiation safety, requirement of scientific officers in addition to other specialists of the field so that an overview regarding pros and cons of the project proposal could be deliberated upon and its feasibility and economic viability in the interest of the University could be assessed.

It is to be ensured that the report of the expert committee is submitted in a time bound manner so as to enable the University, workout a plan pro-actively to avoid any risk of health hazard before initiating any such proposal.
