Agenda Item No. AC 40.02: Action Taken Report on the Proceedings of 39th meeting of the Academic Council, held on 25th June, 2015.

The action taken report on the proceedings of the respective agenda items of 39th meeting of the Academic Council, held on 25th June, 2015 was presented before the Academic Council. The Academic Council noted the actions taken and expressed its satisfaction.

Agenda Item No. AC40.03: To ratify the decision to include additional information, for all programmes of studies governed by the revised University Ordinances No. 10 and 11.

The Academic Council approved the revision of the University Ordinances 10 and 11 in its 39th meeting. While implementing the provisions of these revised Ordinances operational difficulties in declaring results were faced. These operational difficulties were deliberated in the sub-committee of Academic Council. The sub-committee recommended additional information for all the programmes of studies governed by these revised University Ordinances to address the operational difficulties. The additional information pertains to about the programme of study specific data sheet in the scheme and syllabi of examinations was required to specify the apportioning of marks for teacher's continuous evaluation, programme specific passing marks/grades, programme specific promotion rules, Minimum duration of the programme, Maximum duration allowed for completion of the programme, attendance requirement (if at variance with the ordinance), minimum CGPA required for the degree etc On the recommendation of the sub-committee, the Vice Chancellor approved the inclusion of these additional information in the scheme & syllabi of the examinations governed by the University Ordinances 10 & 11. The Academic Council ratified the decision of the Vice Chancellor for the inclusion of the programme of study specific data sheet in the scheme & syllabi of Examinations as pe the revised University Ordinances 10 and 11. Sannexed as Annexure B of Agenda Hea

Agenda Item No. AC40.04: To ratify the notification of the guidelines to address the operationa difficulties arisen due to revision of the University Ordinances No. 10 11 and repealing of Ordinance No.27, for the student batches admitted upto the academic session 2014-2015.

The Academic Council in its 39th meeting (Agenda 39.15) approved the revision of the Universit Ordinances 10 and 11 and repealing of the University Ordinance 27. The revised Ordinances 10 and 1 implemented the grading system of evaluation, changed the evaluation scheme across programmes to uniform system as 25 marks for Teachers' Continuous Evaluation and 75 marks for End-Ten examinations, in theory papers and similarly 40 marks and 60 marks for practical papers.

These changes were implemented from Academic Session 2015-2016. These changes created point of bifurcation in the examination system wherein two different schemes of evaluation (or applicable to regular students admitted till Academic Session 2014-2015 and one applicable for studen admitted from Academic Session 2015-2016) are effective in the University. To keep consistency and



practicability, Academic sub-committee considered the same (31st July, 2015) and recommended following guidelines to address the operational difficulties arisen for student batches admitted till Academic Session 2014-15:

- (i) The promoted student shall be promoted to the next Academic session.
- (ii) The not promoted student shall be promoted to the next Academic session(If required, automatically readmission will be done)
- (iii) Non-promotion due to detention shall also be waived off from this Academic session.

With the approval of the Vice Chancellor, the above guidelines have been implemented. The Academic Council ratified the decision of the Vice Chancellor to implement the above guidelines for the student batches admitted till academic session 2014-15. Agenda Item No. AC40.05:To ratify the decision regarding the specification of degrees as per the University Grants Commission (UGC), Gazette Notification dated 05th July,2014 No.F.5-1/2013(CPP-II).

The University Grants Commission in its Regulation of 2014 regarding nomenclature of degrees specified a list of degrees and required that all degrees offered/awarded by Universities must be within the framework specified in the UGC Regulations 2014 notified vide gazette notification dated 5th July 2014. A Regulation entitled "Nomenclature of Degrees/Diplomas", and the table of equivalence of past degrees awarded, has been framed in pursuance of the above referred UGC Regulations by the University as recommended by a committee constituted by the Competent Authority. The Academic Council after deliberations ratified the University Regulations entitled "Nomenclature of Degrees/Diplomas" and the table of equivalence of past degrees awarded Annexed as Annexure 19-10.

Agenda Item No. AC40.09: To consider and approve the creation of teaching posts for the present and proposed courses in the University School of Biotechnology (USBT), to fulfill the manpower needs for teaching, research and entrepreneurship development in Biotechnology to be implemented w.e.f. the academic session 2016-2017.

The Academic Council appreciated the efforts being made to introduce new courses in near future and to ensure quality teaching and research. The initiatives of the Dean, University School of Biotechnology were also appreciated for focused efforts taking the entrepreneurship development in Biotechnology. The Academic Council has also been apprised that the faculty strength of USBT has stagnated around 11-12 nos. for the last decade, whereas the number of students have increased and the training, research and teaching requirements have expanded significantly. There is a need for new qualified faculty in subjects such as Biochemical Engineering, Bioprocess Technology, Biophysics, Bioinformatics etc, to achieve a balance between Biosciences and Bioengineering expertise for academic and industrial needs in Biotechnology. The above areas are well recognized as gap areas in the faculty profile of USBT alongwith other Bioscience subjects such as developmental biology, neurobiology etc. The M.Tech. curriculum has been recently revised to include the above subjects in anticipation of the sanction of the faculty positions as recommended by the Board of Studies of the USBT.
