





The Academic Council considered and approved the agenda item, as proposed.

Agenda Item No. AC 61.105: To consider and approve acceptance of NOC issued by Delhi Nursing Council and State Government for granting Affiliation to Nursing Institutions.

The Academic Council considered and approved the agenda item, as proposed.

Agenda Item No. AC 61.106: To report/ inform the Fee Structure to be followed/ adopted for various programmes being run in the Schools of Studies/ Centres of the University for admissions made in the Academic Session 2026-2027 onwards.

The Academic Council ratified the agenda item, as reported.

Other Items:

A. The Hon'ble Vice Chancellor shared the update of the *In-situ* Centre for Sustainable Nitrogen and Nutrient Management, USBAS, highlighting that:

- The Centre has been selected for a DBT project of approx. Rs. 90 lakhs under the Biomanufacturing scheme, in addition to another ongoing DBT project of similar amount, bringing the total extramural funding to approx. Rs. 180 lakhs since July 2022.
- The Centre has published recent research articles in reputed international journals and has undertaken outreach for farmer and other stakeholders through Hindi media, including five articles in "Amar Ujala - Gaon Junction", besides extension lectures and webinars.

The Academic Council noted the same.



- B. **Simplifying Admission Framework through CUET:** The Academic Council deliberated upon the admission framework through CUET and suggested that, wherever feasible, a broad-based and flexible subject combination be adopted, such as any three subjects along with General Test, to reduce over-dependence on domain-specific combinations and to provide a more inclusive approach.
- C. **To explore possibilities of filling vacant seats through merit basis:** The Academic Council deliberated upon the admission process and it was suggested to fill vacant seats in PG Programmes, wherever available, on merit basis from the eligible candidates, where the candidate has been admitted through Entrance Test at Under-Graduate/Qualifying Examination Level.
- D. **Uniformity & consolidated submission of the scheme and syllabus of UG/ PG programmes:** The Academic Council advised to ensure uniformity in the scheme of examination and syllabus for all UG/PG programmes being run in both the University Schools of Studies (USS) and the Affiliated Institutions. It was noted that different scheme and syllabus of the programmes exist in USICT and USAR. Accordingly, the Dean, USICT and Dean, USAR were advised to take necessary action to offer the uniform scheme of examination and syllabus across USS and Affiliated Institutions from next Academic Session.


The Academic Council further advised the concerned Schools/Departments to exercise due diligence to eliminate discrepancies, if any, in the scheme of examination and syllabus of the programmes.

It was further resolved that the complete scheme and detailed syllabus of all semesters/years of the programme shall be submitted to the Academic Council for approval/ ratification in one consolidated proposal, and not in a piecemeal manner.

- E. **Generic nomenclature of Ph.D. degree(s) issued by Centre of Excellence in Pharmaceutical Sciences (CEPS):** The Council resolved that the Ph.D. degree(s) awarded in the Centre of Excellence in Pharmaceutical Sciences (CEPS) shall be in the broader discipline i.e. Pharmaceutical Sciences.
- F. **Institution of awards/ prizes/ medals by affiliated colleges/ Institutions:** The Academic Council resolved that any awards/ prizes/ medals instituted by the affiliated colleges/ institutions of the University shall be in consonance with the University Ordinances.

Concluding the meeting, the Hon'ble Vice Chancellor expressed his sincere gratitude to all the members for attending the meeting and for their valuable inputs.
