Some of the Board members gave suggestions as mentioned below:-

- 1. Prof. Raj Bahadur suggested for implementation of Endowment Fund for the self financing affiliated institutes. Joint Registrar (Affiliation) informed that the practice of Endownment Fund which was earlier functional has been discontinued. The Board advised that Endownment Fund be revived and be charged from the institutes. Prof. (Dr.) Sanjay Srivastava also consented to the proposal for implementation of Endowment Fund as applicable in Bar Council India & National Medical Commission (earlier MCI).
- 2. Prof. Raj Bahadur also suggested that the inspection of the institutes should not be carried out on yearly basis. The Vice Chancellor apprised that the inspection on yearly basis is carried out as a mandatory requirement as per the relevant Ordinance of the University. Further, the NOC are issued year to year basis by the concerned State Government and Statutory Bodies.
- 3. Prof. Om Vikas suggested that there is need to revisit the curricula of various programmes in the light of NEP 2020. GGSIPU may consider to evolve model curricula for some of the programmes with growing demand like CSE, IT, AI&ML, AI&DS, etc. Nomenclature of the programs may also be decided and intersiciplinary courses may also be identified, and mentored by the faculty of the University. Prof. Om Vikas also suggested that a new course such as Design Science may also be started in affiliated institutes keeping in view the great demand for the course. The Vice Chancellor apprised that the University already has a School of Design in the East Delhi Campus. He also agreed to form a committee involving faculty of Computer Science & Management Scholars and Design Professionals for deciding the course curriculum to add value to the disciplines/streams in light of National Education Policy-2020.
- 4. Prof. M.N. Doja suggested that a Curriculum Development Workshop may be conducted for students on different courses by the University.
- 5. Prof. (Dr.) Ritu Duggal gave suggestion for strengthening placement of students. The Vice Chancellor agreed to look into the matter for appointing one more placement officer in the University and also to strengthen alumni and promote industrial interaction. He also advised to work out a system to devise a mechanism to track students who go abroad for higher studies/employment.
- 6. Prof. (Dr.) Ritu Duggal also pointed out the need for one more Dental College in the University to function as a PG centre for fellowship programmes and for enhancing skills in Dental Science.
- 7. Prof. A. K. Agarwal suggested to increase the number of publications in the University as well as in the institute level in order to enhance the standard of the University which can thereby be reflected in NAAC grading.
