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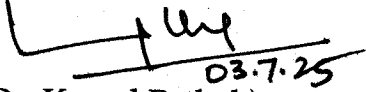

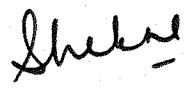

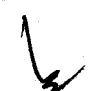

University Rankings 2026. This marks the University's debut amongst top 1000 Universities of the world in the prestigious global ranking.

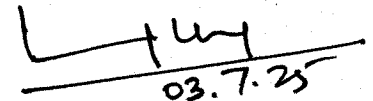
