C Admission to B.A. (Honours) in Economics

The admissions to B. A. (Honours) - Economics 'three year full time 'Bachelor Degree (Honours) Programme in Economics' in the affiliated institutions of the G.G.S Indraprastha University will be held from the Academic Session, 2017-18. The admission to the course shall be based on a Common Entrance Test (CET) conducted by the university.

2. All applicants must appear in the appropriate CET for admission.
3. Only CET qualified applicants shall be considered for admission, through the University Counselling, subject to fulfilment of eligibility and admission criteria.
4. All the candidates shall submit application forms only through online mode for the Common Entrance Tests 2017. The application form along with the Common Entrance Test Fee of Rs.1000/- excluding processing charges and taxes, as applicable, shall be available from 15.05.2017.

Programme Objectives

4. To give students a thorough understanding of Economic concepts and analytical methods of Economics.
5. To provide the students an opportunity to pursue courses that give equal emphasis on quantitative and theoretical aspects of Economics.

Eligibility Criteria & Admission Procedure

Candidates with an aggregate of 50% marks in 10 + 2 level examination from a recognized state and central government board (for example, C.B.S.E) with compulsory mathematics (at 10+2 level) would be eligible to apply and appear in the entrance exam.

The admission to the course would be based on a Common Entrance Test (CET) conducted by the university. The Common Entrance exam shall comprise of 150 multiple choice questions (MCQs). Candidates would be assessed based on their knowledge and skills in general English, Economics, Statistics and Mathematical skills at 10+2 level as per the following broad examination criteria :
