

Notice

Grand Intra Moot Court Competition-2nd September, 2017

In continuation with the notice dated 05/08/2017 regarding Grand Intra Moot Court Competition, the students of USLLS are hereby informed about the following:

1. **The Competition will now be conducted on 03.09.17**, due to the festival of Id-ul-Zuha on 02.09.17.

2. The rules for preparation of memorial are as follows:

i) Each Team participating in the Competition must prepare Memorial from the side allotted to them after draw of lots.

ii) The Memorial must contain the following parts only:

1	Cover Page;
2	Table of Contents;
3	Index of Authorities;
4	Statement of Jurisdiction;
5	Questions Presented;
6	Statement of Facts;
7	Summary of Pleadings; and
8	Pleadings (including Conclusion/Prayer for Relief).

iii) Cover Page

iv) The front cover of each Memorial must have the following information:

v) The Team number in the upper right-hand corner followed by "P" if a Petitioner Memorial or "R" if a Respondent Memorial (e.g., Team Number 23 would put "23P " in the top right hand corner of the front cover of its Petitioner Memorial);

- vi) The name of the court (i.e., "Supreme Court of Industan");
- vii) The year of the Competition (the year during which the relevant Round takes place);
- viii) The name of the case; and
- ix) The title of the document (i.e., "Memorial for Respondent" or "Memorial for Petitioner").
- x) The Index of Authorities must list all legal authorities cited in any part of the Memorial and must indicate the page number(s) of the Memorial on which each authority is cited.
- xi) Footnotes must be used to identify the source of statements or propositions made in the body of the Memorial. Endnotes are not permitted. Footnotes may include substantive pleadings in addition to the text of the citation itself.
- xii) Length**
 - a) The word count shall be conducted using the standard "WordCount" feature in Microsoft Word 2007 or Microsoft Word 2010.
 - b) The total length of the Pleadings, including the section headings, Conclusion/Prayer for Relief, and any associated footnotes, must be no longer than 9,000 words.
 - c) The Summary of Pleadings, including section headings and any associated footnotes, must be no longer than 700 words.
 - d) The Statement of Facts, including section headings and any associated footnotes, must be no longer than 1,200 words.
 - e) The Participating Teams shall be allotted a "Team Code" after the Registration. Teams "shall not reveal identity" in any form, except the Team Code allotted to them during the Competition. Names of participants, may not appear on or within the Memorials. Signature pages are prohibited.
- xiii) Presentation of the Memorial**
 - a) The Memorial shall be spiral-bound only.
