INTERNATIONAL FELLOWSHIPS FOR RESEARCH STUDENTS

Govt. of Japan announces to offer 10 (Ten) UNESCO/Keizo Obuchi Research Fellowship for researchers of Developing countries including India. The aim of the fellowships is to support innovative and imaginative post graduate research in the following four areas of particular interest to UNESCO -

- 1. Environment (with particular attention on Disaster Risk Reduction (DRR).
- 2. Intercultural Dialogue.
- 3. Information and Communication Technologies.
- Peaceful conflict resolution.
 No other research topics will be considered.

Application deadline - November 30, 2018

- Scholarship Award: The fellowships shall be financed by Japan and administered by UNESCO and will consist of the following:
- (i) A lump sum contribution of US\$10,000 will be awarded to selected candidates. The amount, to be paid in two or three installments, is intended to cover research costs only, and will not be negotiable.
- (ii)No other costs will be considered and grants will be neither extended nor renewed.
- How to apply: All applications must be submitted with the required documentation on the UNESCO fellowship application form through National Commission. The application(s) should reach the Section of Participation Programme and Fellowship, UNESCO, 7, Place de Fontenoy 75352 Paris 07 SP before 30 November 2018 midnight and an advance copy may be sent by e-mail: s.bantchev-at-unesco.org and I.zas-friz-atunesco.org.
