IMPORTANT DATES:

8th November: Deadline for registration and sending a soft copy of the technical paper along with a brief abstract.

E- mail subject should be TPP. Format should be Microsoft Word 2003(.doc) only.

10th November: Deadline to confirm arrival details. Email subject should be ARRIVAL.

RULES AND REGULATIONS:

- Each Participant must formally present his/her presentation at the day of the event. It must be no longer than 8 minutes. The time limit should be strictly followed.
- A 2 minute question and answer session will follow the presentation. Questions may be posed by the judges or students attending the event.
- Presentations must be brought in a pen drive on the day of the event.
- All the participants are required to bring two hard copies of their paper along with them on the day of the event.

GUIDELINES:

- Presentation should be done on – stage.
- Format-Microsoft PowerPoint 2003 or Microsoft Word 2003.
- Audio-visual equipments such as laptop, digital projection system will be provided.

- It is always handy to carry a laptop along with you. It will be helpful in case of any technical problem.

TIPS AND SUGGESTIONS:

TEXT- keep the text as brief as possible. Try to organize data in form of points. Make the text on the slides big enough to make it readable.

BACKGROUND-background and the text should be in contrasting colors to enhance the readability.

GRAPHS AND FIGURES: You may represent the data graphically wherever possible. A well documented figure is way more attractive than a lengthy text.

SPEECH- Speak clearly and loudly. For a typical 8 minute presentation you should not exceed 15 slides. You may animate your slides but not too much.

RESULT AN DISCUSSION- Start with a brief recap. Give your hypothesis with scientific proof to support them. You must tell the significance of your research and what should be done next regarding it.

JUDGING CRITERIA:

Judging will be on the basis of 100 marks. The decision of the honorable judges will be considered as final.
