**Subject: Regarding Central Sector Schemes of Scholarship for Colleges and University Students.**

Secretary, MHRD, GOI has directed to complete the following targets as per their time line:

- (i) Seeding of existing Aadhaar number into bank accounts of students by 31<sup>st</sup> August, 2016.
- (ii) Collection of biometrics for Aadhaar enrolment of students not having Aadhaar by 31<sup>st</sup> August, 2016. The student can enroll for Aadhaar card at any permanent enrolment center as per his/her convenience. The student can enroll centres are available on resident portal of UIDAI (<https://residents.uidai.net.in>).
- (iii) Seeding of Aadhaar numbers into bank accounts by 15<sup>th</sup> September, 2016.
- (iv) Submission of applications in respect of Central Sector Scheme of Scholarship for College and University Students on the Scholarship Portal by 30<sup>th</sup> September, 2016.

Directorate of Higher Education, Govt. of NCT of Delhi has requested to take all the requisite steps as per aforementioned time line, to ensure that all eligible students as per eligibility criteria under different Scholarship schemes of different Ministries of GOI cannot deprived of their respective scholarship amount.

All Directors/Principals of Self Financing Institutes affiliated with GGSIPU/ Govt. Institutes are requested to do needful as requested by Director, Directorate of Higher Education, Govt. of NCT of Delhi.

All Deans/Directors/Principals of USS/ Affiliated Institutes/Govt. Colleges are requested to display it on their Notice Board for information of the eligible students.

The student can enroll for Aadhaar card at any permanent enrolment center as per his/her convenience. The details of Aadhaar enrolment centres are available on resident portal of UIDAI (<https://resident.uidai.net.in>).
- (iii) Seeding of Aadhaar numbers into bank accounts by **15<sup>th</sup> September, 2016**.
- (iv) Submission of applications in respect of Central Sector Scheme of Scholarship for College and University Students on the Scholarship Portal by **30<sup>th</sup> September, 2016**.

2. Applications for scholarships need to be submitted through the National Scholarship Portal (<http://scholarships.gov.in/>) where the Aadhaar number of the beneficiary would be required while applying. For the scholarship scheme administered by this Department, that is, the Central Sector Scheme of Scholarship for College and University students, the last date for applying online is 30<sup>th</sup> September, 2016. In view of this, it is necessary that all students, who are entitled for a scholarship, are enrolled for Aadhaar.

3. For Direct Benefit Transfer, the bank accounts of the beneficiary need to be seeded with the Aadhaar number. The Higher Education Departments in the States are requested to undertake, in a campaign mode, the enrolment of all students for Aadhaar by the end of August 2016. If there are large number of students in a higher education institution requiring Aadhaar number, then enrolment camps in the institution itself may be organised to obtain biometric data. If the number to be covered is small, then the scholarship holders may be taken to the nearest Permanent Enrolment Centre by the respective institutions. Once the Aadhaar number is received, the Aadhaar is required to be seeded with the students' bank account to enable Aadhaar based payment of the scholarship.
