Reference to the letter no. MCI-23(1)/2014/Med./153433 dated 28/01/2015 received from Medical Council of India (MCI), decision regarding Post graduate Examinations for Post Graduate courses are as under:

“Post Graduate Examination

The Academic Committee noted regarding the Postgraduate Examinations that the students are required to pass theory and practical examination separately in terms of the governing provisions pertaining to the scheme of examination in the Postgraduate Regulation and recommended that an examinee should obtain minimum 40% marks in each theory paper and not less than 50% marks cumulatively in all the four papers for degree examination and three papers in Diploma examination to be cleared as “passed” at the said Degree/ Diploma examination as the case may be.”

The same shall be applicable to the batch / students admitted in Academic Session 2015-16 and onwards.
