## Course Contents:

#### Unit:- 1

To familiarize students with the Japanese language, with its phonetic system and its pronunciation. Salutations & greetings, to greet someone in Japanese, Self-introduction, Introduction & background to Japanese scripts, History of Japan, Culture of Japan, Counting, to present oneself and describe people, to establish contact with someone and begin a conversation to talk about one's family, tastes and preferences

#### Unit:- 2

To furnish the linguistic tools- Japanese scripts of Hiragana & Katakana, Classroom instructions in Japanese, Days & months, Date and time, Basic understanding of grammar and texts in Japanese, family names, family tree chart, Numerals in Hiragana, Asking basic questions, Audio-visual lectures/movies/dramas etc.

#### Unit:- 3

Visiting a person, meet someone's family & deal with various conversations. Country, people & language, Start conversations, Usage of particles, Audio-visual lectures/movies/dramas etc., Japanese verbs, Phone, business card & letter, Talk on the phone, Asking basic questions.

#### Unit:- 4

Introduction to i & na adjectives, colour & taste, Weather & seasons, Grammar for like & dislike. Go to the movies, talk about movies, talk about sports, Go for sightseeing, say numbers, How to order in a restaurant, Audio-visual lectures/movies/dramas etc.

#### Unit:- 5

To strengthen the language of the students in both oral and written. To revise the grammar in application and the communication tasks related to topics covered already. To enable the students to visit railway station, take tickets, grammar patterns, learn different occupation, to withdraw money, Audio-visual lectures/movies/dramas etc. Body & illness etc.

#### Unit:- 6

To enhance social communication skills and be able to handle different scenarios by using Japanese language skills, actions & grammar patterns involved, Traditional culture & entertainment, How to address people, Audio-visual lectures/movies/dramas etc., Polite style & Plain style of speech

#### Unit :- 7

To enable the students to talk about positions in society, To talk about clothes, Verb, Audio-visual lectures/movies/dramas etc. Learn road & traffic rules, To develop skits based on above scenarios

Assessment: Oral: 50 marks, Written: 50 marks; Total: 100 marks
