1. All the candidates who have filled application form and paid Rs. 2500/- (Rs. 1500/- Registration & Rs. 1,000/- Counseling participation fees – non-refundable) are eligible to attend verification of documents followed by "Personal Interview with the Candidates for preparation of merit for admission in Nurse Practitioner in Critical Care (NPCC) – Prog. Note :- Those candidates who have filled application form and have not paid Rs. 2500/- at the time of applying for the said Academic Programme i.e., NPCC may attend the 2nd Counseling and bring a DD of Rs. 2500/- (non-refundable) alongwith Bank Draft of Rs. 96,000/- (Part Academic Fee) is required at the time counselling in favour of Registrar, Guru Gobind Singh Indraprastha University payable at Delhi.

2. Eligibility Criteria for Programme- Nurse Practitioner in Critical Care (NPCC) – Prog. Code 116

- The candidate should be a Registered Nurse and Registered Midwife with any State Nursing Registration Council
- The Minimum education requirements shall be the passing of:-
 - B.Sc. Nursing/ B.Sc. (Hons.) Nursing/Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing/M.Sc. Nursing with minimum of 55% aggregate marks from an institution which is recognized by Indian Nursing Council.
- Minimum one year of work experience after Basic B.Sc. Nursing (preferably Critical Care Units)
- Minimum one year of work experience prior to Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing (preferably Critical Care Units)
- Candidate should be medically fit

The merit for admission will be on the basis of interview (25% weightage for interview & 75% for marks obtained in the last qualifying examination)

3. All the Candidates are required to bring following documents for verification and for preparation of merit list.

a) Bank Draft(s) of Rs. 96000/- (Part Academic Fee) is required at the time counselling in favour of Registrar, Guru Gobind Singh Indraprastha University, payable at Delhi. The candidate will write his name, date of admission, phone, address, mobile no, name of the programme, and CET Roll Number on the back of the Bank Draft(s). Balance fee (if applicable) shall be paid by the candidate at the allotted institute.

b) Four passport sized photographs

c) Filled Admission verification form as per Appendix 5 of Part F of Admission Brochure 2026-27.

d) Filled Preference sheet as per Appendix 10 of Part F of Admission Brochure 2026-27.

e) Proof of date of birth (Secondary School Mark-sheet & Certificate) (Original and Photocopy)

f) Mark-sheets/Certificates of qualifying examination:

The candidate will be required to bring the Original certificates/Mark-sheets of all the year wise or semester wise in original along with photocopy of Certificates/ Mark-sheets of qualifying examination.

g) For Distance / Open Learning Cases:

In case of students who have passed the qualifying examination through distance / open education system of any recognized University / Board / Institution, the necessary documentary evidence related to location of his / her study centre i.e. study centre proof, certificate from the University imparting open / distance education certifying the location of the study centre to be submitted.

h) Physical Fitness Certificate:

All the students shall be required to submit a Medical Certificate indicating fitness from a Registered Medical Practitioner as per format given in Performa of Medical Certificate in given in Part-F in Admission Brochure 2026-27 (As per Appendix 4).

i) Result Awaited: candidates seeking admission as result awaited candidate must have to submit Appendix 3 of Part F of Admission Brochure 2026-2027.

j) Reserved Category Certificate in addition to Appendix 12:

The candidates seeking admission under reserved categories, must have to mandatorily bring the entitled supporting certificate in his/her name. The Candidates for further details **must read Chapter 6 (Reservation Policy)** of respective Admission Brochure 2026-27.

In case the candidate is claiming the seat reserved for DSC/DST/DOBC category then he/she should have passed his/ her qualifying exam from Delhi School/College and must have SC/ST/OBC certificate issued by the Competent Authority of Govt. of NCT of Delhi only.

Reserved Category Candidates who fail either to bring documents as per notified schedule or whose documents are not in order will forfeit his/her right for the reserved category claimed and will automatically be converted to General Category as per University rules.

All reservation category candidates who are seeking admission in reserved category in SC/ST/DEF/PWD/OBC/EWS/KM must bring their reservation certificate (the caste/category certificate should invariably be in the name of candidate himself/herself and not in favour of respective parents/guardians) in original along with the self attested photocopy of the certificate for claiming seat against the reserved category.

k) Conduct and Character Certificate in original from the Head of the Institution from where the qualifying examination has been passed or from Gazetted officer in Original, not more than 06 (six) months old.

l) There is no OBC and EWS seats in self financed and minority institute.

m) Application regarding age relaxation with necessary approval shall be submitted by 11.08.2026 prior two days before the commencement of Offline counselling (if necessary).

n) The required Certificate(s) for reserved categories / classes will be essential at the time of the counselling / admission and no provisional admission shall be admissible for want of caste/category certificate from the local competent authority. Further, the caste / category certificate should invariably be in the name of the candidate himself / herself and not in favour of respective parents / guardians.

o) A candidate, who fails to exercise the option in person during Second Counselling, shall forfeit his/ her right for a vacant seat even if he or she had higher rank, for which the University will not be responsible. The students having taken admission in second counselling would not be allowed to change the programme/institute in the subsequent days of 2nd Counselling. In the interest of the students, it is advised that they should carefully select the programme/institute before taking admission in the second counselling. Candidates once enrolled in the University at the end of counselling will not be considered for admission through Management Quota.

- p) The rest of the procedure for Second Counselling shall remain the same as followed during the first counselling.
 - q) Those candidates who have filled application form and have not paid Rs. 2500/- at the time of applying for the said Academic Programme i.e., NPCC may attend the 2nd Counseling and bring a DD of Rs. 2500/- (non-refundable) alongwith Bank Draft of Rs. 96,000/- (Part Academic Fee) is required at the time counselling in favour of Registrar, Guru Gobind Singh Indraprastha University payable at Delhi.
 - r) Open House Counselling/spot counselling: Counselling on the Open Day will be held only if any seat(s) remains vacant after two rounds of counselling. The said seat(s) will be offered on that day to the qualified candidate(s) in order of merit. The seat(s) shall be offered to the qualified candidate(s) in order of merit irrespective of his/her Region provided he/she has reported for counselling on that day.
 - s) Reporting-Candidates who are admitted in Round 01 and Round 02 are advised to report in the college latest by 17.08.2026.

It will also be the sole responsibility of the candidates themselves to make sure that they are eligible and fulfill all the conditions prescribed for admission. Before filling-up the verification slip at the time of verification of documents/counselling/allotment of seats, candidate should ensure that he/she fulfills all eligibility conditions as laid down in the respective Admission Brochure for the session 2026-27. If it is found at any stage during the entire period of the programme that the candidate does not fulfill the requisite eligibility conditions, his/her admission will be cancelled and also disciplinary action will be initiated against his/her and entire fee will also be forfeited.
